AN ACT RESTRICTING THE SALE OF REAL ESTATE PROPERTY INSURANCE BY CERTAIN BROKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 166 the following section:—

3 *Section 166A.* No broker or insurance agent who is also a
4 member of any board of assessors of any city or town within the
5 commonwealth shall have authority under his license to nego-
6 tiate or sell real estate property insurance to any inhabitant of
7 the city or town which he serves.
