AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ASSUMPTION BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF FIFTY PER CENT OF THE COST OF MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF BUNKER HILL MONUMENT, GEORGE'S ISLAND AND CASTLE ISLAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The treasurer of the commonwealth is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to pay fifty per cent of the cost of maintenance and op-
- 3 eration of Bunker Hill monument, George's Island and Castle
- 4 Island, in conjunction with the metropolitan district commission.
