AN ACT PROVIDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR CONTRACTS OF THE  
METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no con-  
2 tract by the Metropolitan Transit Authority for the purchase of  
3 equipment, supplies or materials, the actual or estimated cost of  
4 which amounts to one thousand dollars or more, except in cases  
5 of special emergency, shall be awarded unless proposals for the  
6 same have been invited by advertisement in at least one news-  
7 paper published in the city of Boston, such publication to be at  
8 least one week before the time specified for the opening of said  
9 proposals. Such advertisement shall state the time and place  
10 for opening the proposals in answer to said advertisement, and  
11 shall reserve the right to reject any or all such proposals. All  
12 such proposals shall be opened in public. No bill or contract  
13 shall be split or divided for the purpose of evading any provisions  
14 of this section.
