AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONS AS EMPLOYEES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end the following sentence:—
3 No employee shall be hired or employed by the Authority unless
4 such person has a place of residence within the district served
5 by the Authority.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
