AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DATES OF FISHING IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 45 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1953,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 2 of the second
4 paragraph, the words "where such open season seems advisable",
5 and inserting in place thereof the words:— on and after the
6 second Saturday in April of each year; and by striking out, in
7 line 4 of said second paragraph, the words "time and length of
8 open season."
