## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE POLICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (c) of subdivision (3) of section 26 of chapter 32 of  
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of  
3 chapter 670 of the acts of 1951, is hereby further amended by  
4 adding at the end the following sentence: — On January first of  
5 every year the retirement allowance payable to any former em-  
6 ployee who has been retired under the provisions of this sub-  
7 division shall be increased to an amount not exceeding one half  
8 the rate of regular compensation payable to employees referred  
9 to in this subdivision at the time of increasing such allowance,  
10 in the same grade or classification occupied by such former em-  
11 ployee at the time of his retirement and such increased retire-  
12 ment allowance shall be further increased by one twelfth of one  
13 per cent for each month of full service in excess of twenty years  
14 as provided in the preceding sentence.
