AN ACT RELATIVE TO CIVIL DEFENSE ALERTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary all
2 traffic will stop for fifteen minutes and persons shall be off the
3 streets during a civil defense alert. A person convicted of violat-
4 ing the provisions of this act shall pay a fine of five dollars.
