## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS OF SEVENTY-FIVE PER CENT OF ALL FUNDS EXPENDED FOR RELIEF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the law  
2 to the contrary, the commonwealth shall reimburse the cities  
3 and towns seventy-five per cent of all sums disbursed for relief  
4 categories, under their respective departments of public welfare,  
5 including, but not limited to, veterans' relief, assistance to the  
6 aged, the handicapped and indigent persons.

1 SECTION 2. Sufficient funds to carry out the provisions of this  
2 act may be appropriated.
