AN ACT TO INCREASE THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE CHARGED FOR
LATE PAYMENT OF REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 57 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2 section 1 of chapter 278 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence: — Interest shall be paid at
5 the rate of seven per cent per annum on all real estate and per-
6 sonal property taxes remaining unpaid after November first of
7 the year in which they are payable, computed from October
8 first of such year.
