## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO INSURE THE CONTINUING USE OF CERTAIN PARK LANDS  
IN THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR RECREATIONAL AND RELATED PRO-  
GRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law gen-  
2 eral or special to the contrary any land deeded to the city of  
3 Boston and in the custody, care or control of any board, depart-  
4 ment or agency for a period of twenty years or more shall not  
5 be sold for commercial purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**The Constitution of the State**

As amended by the Constitution of 1870

ARTICLE I. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives, which shall be styled the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. The Senate shall be composed of twelve members, who shall be elected by the electors of the State for a term of four years.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen every second year by the electors in each county, and the number of representatives shall not exceed one for every ten thousand qualified electors.

SECTION 3. The House shall have the sole power of originating bills for raising revenue.
