By Mr. Walsh of Boston, petition of Edward Fleming that the Board of Registration in Chiropody (Podiatry) be authorized to examine him for registration as a chiropodist (podiatrist). Public Health.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIGIBILITY OF EDWARD FLEMING, FOR
REGISTRATION AS A CHIROPODIST (PODIATRIST).

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of law, Edward
2 Fleming shall be forthwith examined for registration as a chi-
3 ropodist (podiatrist) by the board of registration in chiropody
4 and shall, upon successfully qualifying, receive therefrom a
5 certificate of registration signed by the members of the board
6 or a majority of them in or within twenty days. The said Ed-
7 ward Fleming shall have the same benefit of and be subject to
8 the same provisions of law as any other holder of such a certifi-
9 cate of registration.
