AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A YOUTH COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Arlington is hereby authorized to
2 raise by taxation and to appropriate such sums of money as may
3 be authorized by a majority vote of the voters of said town,
4 voting thereon at an annual town meeting, for the purpose of
5 supporting a youth committee formed for the prevention, treat-
6 ment and control of youth problems in said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
