RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE PROBLEM OF AIR POLLUTION AND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL INCLUDING THE ADVISABILITY OF INSTALLING MOTOR VEHICLE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DEVICES ON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established by  
2 chapter seventy-two of the resolves of nineteen hundred and  
3 sixty-one is hereby revived and continued for the purpose of  
4 continuing its investigation and study relative to the problem  
5 of air pollution and air pollution control, including the advisa-  
6 bility of requiring motor vehicle air pollution control devices to  
7 be installed on motor vehicles registered in the commonwealth.  
8 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state  
9 house or elsewhere, may travel within and without the common-  
10 wealth, may hold hearings, may require by summons the attend-  
11 ance and testimony of witnesses and the production of books and  
12 papers, and may expend for expert, legal, technical, clerical and  
13 other services and assistance such sums as may be appropriated  
14 therefor. Said commission shall report to the general court the  
15 results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,  
16 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its  
17 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of  
18 the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday  
19 of December in the current year.
