RESOLUTIONS REQUESTING THE COLUMBIA BROADCASTING SYSTEM TO SHOW THE FILM "BIOGRAPHY OF A BOOKIE JOINT", IN MASSACHUSETTS.

¶ *Whereas*, The people of Massachusetts have been denied an opportunity to view the television film "Biography of a Bookie Joint"; and

Whereas, The public interest requires that the people of Massachusetts be afforded the opportunity to view this television documentary in its entirety; and

Whereas, The people of Massachusetts have a right to see and to judge for themselves the context and background of certain statements and allegations made therein by a member of the House of Representatives; and

Whereas, The viewing of this film in its entirety by the people of Massachusetts will enable them to place in proper perspective these statements and allegations; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives respectfully requests the Columbia Broadcasting System to show the film "Biography of a Bookie Joint" to the people of Massachusetts at its earliest possible convenience.
