AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE SUMMIT HOUSE
LOCATED ON MOUNT SUGAR LOAF IN THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD AS
A MEMORIAL TO THE VETERANS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The commissioners of the Mount Sugar Loaf
2 Reservation are hereby authorized and directed to demolish
3 and remove the structure known as the "Summit House",
4 located on Mount Sugar Loaf in the town of Deerfield and to
5 erect a new structure in place thereof. For such purpose, the
6 commissioners may expend therefor such funds as may be
7 appropriated by the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. The new building shall be designated and ap-
2 propriately named by said commissioners as a memorial to the
3 citizens of Franklin county, both living and dead, who served
4 our nation in time of war.
