PROPOSED LEGISLATION.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

RESOLVE EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO CONFLICT OF INTERESTS AND ETHICS IN GOVERNMENT SHALL MAKE ITS FINAL REPORT.

1 *Resolved*, That the time within which the unpaid special com-
2 mission, established by section two of chapter six hundred and
3 ten of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-one to make an in-
4 vestigation and study relative to the existing laws relating to
5 conflict of interests and ethics in government, shall make its
6 final report to the general court is hereby extended to March
7 thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
