AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALARY INCREASES IN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 241 of the acts of 1875,
2 as amended by section 2 of chapter 121 of the acts of 1933, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the last two sentences
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— They
5 may fix the compensation of the teachers; but the salaries estab-
6 lished for the teachers at the commencement of each school year
7 shall not be increased during such year; nor shall they at any
8 time increase the salary of any person in the service of the school
9 department or of any vacant office or position therein unless there
10 is a specific provision for such increase in an appropriation order.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter three hundred and forty-six of the acts
2 of nineteen hundred and fifty-seven is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
