AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO PAY A SUM OF  
MONEY TO ANDREW L. MOORE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-  
2 trary, and in order to discharge a moral obligation of the county  
3 of Middlesex, the treasurer of said county shall pay from any  
4 available funds to Andrew L. Moore of Cambridge the sum of  
5 dollars as compensation for services rendered by him  
6 as acting clerk and first assistant clerk of the third district court  
7 of eastern Middlesex during July, August and September of  
8 nineteen hundred and sixty, said payment to be in addition to  
9 any compensation already paid for such services.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

1. Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, and in order to effectuate a more efficient operation of the county of Alameda, the treasurer of said county shall pay from any available funds to (a) the county clerk the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars as compensation for services rendered for this \_\_\_\_\_ acting clerk and first assistant clerk of the third district court of eastern Alameda during July, August and September of 1962 (fifteen hundred and sixty-two) in addition to any compensation already paid for such services.

2. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
