RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON TAXATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission, known as the
2 special commission on taxation, established by chapter eighty-
3 six of the resolves of nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and most
4 recently revived and further continued by chapter eighteen of the
5 resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-one, shall, in the course
6 of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of
7 current house documents numbered 696, relative to providing a
8 deduction for certain dependents who are students at educational
9 institutions; 1171, relative to deductions for certain dependents
10 under the income tax law; and 2605, relative to providing for a
11 deduction under income tax laws for children attending college
12 on a full-time basis.
