By Mr. Kenefick of Lowell, petition of Archibald E. Kenefick for an investigation and study by the Department of Public Utilities relative to the improvement of safety conditions at or near Pawtucket Street railroad bridge in the city of Lowell. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF SAFETY CONDITIONS AT OR NEAR PAWTUCKET STREET RAILROAD BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF LOWELL.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities is hereby au-  
2 thorized and directed to make an investigation and study rela-  
3 tive to the Pawtucket street railroad bridge in the city of Lowell  
4 and the approaches thereto to determine the reasonableness, for  
5 motor vehicle use, of the design and location of said bridge with  
6 its present approaches, and the obligation of the Boston and  
7 Maine Railroad Company to provide a facility at this location,  
8 suitable to reduce the existing accident frequency which occurs  
9 in the operation of motor vehicles using reasonable care, over  
10 said Pawtucket street railroad bridge and to determine the ever-  
11 all adequacy of the combined bridge and approaches with regard  
12 to their safety for use by the operators of motor vehicles.

13 The said department shall report to the general court the  
14 results of its investigation and study and its recommendations,  
15 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
16 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk  
17 of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday  
18 of December in the current year.
