RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON TAXATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission, known as the
2 special commission on taxation, established by chapter eighty-six
3 of the resolves of nineteen hundred and forty-eight and most
4 recently revived and further continued by chapter eighteen of the
5 resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-one, shall, in the course
6 of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of
7 current house document numbered 1905, relative to providing
8 financial aid for driver education.
