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HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, March 28, 1962.

The committee on Insurance, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 223) of Samuel Harmon that provision be made for a plan of apportionment and service charges for certain persons who are unable to obtain fire insurance; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 224) of Samuel Harmon that foreign fire insurance companies be authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth for the purpose of issuing insurance coverage to certain persons who have been refused coverage by one or more insurance companies; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1086) of Julius Ansel that provision be made for a plan of apportionment and service charges for certain persons who are unable to obtain fire insurance; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1539) of Alfred S. Brothers and Royal L. Bolling that provision be made for a plan of apportionment and service charges for certain persons who are unable to obtain fire insurance; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1541) of Guy R. Peznola, Jr., that insurance companies refusing to issue compulsory motor vehicle liability insurance policies or cancelling or failing to renew such policies be required to notify the applicant of the reasons for such denial, cancellation or refusal, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 3542).

RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE RELATIVE TO THE SECURING OF FIRE INSURANCE, PLAN OF APPORTIONMENT AND SERVICE CHARGES THEREFOR, BY CERTAIN PERSONS UNABLE TO OBTAIN SUCH INSURANCE.

1 *Resolve*, That the investigation and study by the division of  
2 insurance, authorized by chapter one hundred and fourteen of  
3 the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and the time for  
4 filing its final report extended by chapter thirty-one of the re-  
5 solves of nineteen hundred and sixty-two, shall, in the course of  
6 its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of cur-  
7 rent house documents numbered 223, relative to providing for  
8 the securing of fire insurance, plan of apportionment and service  
9 charges therefor, by certain persons unable to obtain such in-  
10 surance; 224, relative to authorizing certain foreign fire insur-  
11 ance companies to transact business in the commonwealth for  
12 certain applicants for fire insurance policies; 1086, relative to  
13 providing for the securing of fire insurance, plan of apportion-  
14 ment and service charges therefor, by certain persons unable to  
15 obtain such insurance; 1539, relative to providing for the secur-  
16 ing of fire insurance, plan of apportionment and service charges  
17 therefor, by certain persons unable to obtain such insurance;  
18 and 1541, relative to requiring full notice of denial or refusal by  
19 insurance company to insure.
