### AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 34 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 5, as most recently amended by section 3 of  
3 chapter 743 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 5.* The salaries of county commissioners, payable by  
6 their respective counties in full for all services performed by said  
7 commissioners except as otherwise provided, shall be as fol-  
8 lows:—
