RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW SUPERIOR COURTHOUSE IN MIDDLESEX COUNTY.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, one person to be appointed
5 by the governor, the chairman of the county commissioners
6 of Middlesex county, and the clerk of the superior court of said
7 county, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
8 investigation and study relative to the advisability of con-
9 structing a new superior courthouse in said county. Said com-
10 mission shall consider the type of building, if any, which should
11 be constructed and what facilities such building should provide
12 for offices of Middlesex county in addition to accommodations
13 for the superior court.
