RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY OF WORCESTER.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the adequate collection, treatment and disposal of
4 sanitary sewage and industrial waste originating in the city of
5 Worcester and the towns of Auburn, Boylston, Charlton, Dudley,
6 Grafton, Holden, Leicester, Millbury, Oxford, Paxton, Prince-
7 ton, Rutland, Shrewsbury, Southbridge, Sterling, Webster and
8 West Boylston. Said department shall consider the various
9 methods of collection and disposal of sewage and the applica-
10 tion of such methods to the existing sewerage systems and treat-
11 ment facilities in said city and in said towns and shall recommend
12 such methods, as it deems best, together with estimates of the
13 costs thereof.

14 Said department shall have access to all plans, reports and
15 specifications of said city and towns and of any person, corpora-
16 tion or industry located therein relative to sewerage and sewage
17 disposal and waste disposal. For the purposes of this resolve
18 said department may employ such engineering and other assist-
19 ants as may be necessary and may expend such sums as may be
20 appropriated therefor. Said department shall report its find-
21 ings and recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legis-
22 lation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect by
23 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on
24 or before the first Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred
25 and sixty-three.
