AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT THE POSITION OF NEGOTIATOR IN THE RIGHT OF WAY DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 606 of the acts of 1960 is hereby amended by adding
- 2 at the end the following paragraph:—
- 3 The provisions of this act shall include a minimum of eighty
- 4 permanent positions as negotiator in the right-of-way division of
- 5 the department of public works; said positions to be filled,
- 6 forthwith, from the certified civil service list established on
- 7 June thirteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-one. Salaries of
- 8 said negotiators shall be charged to and made payable from the
- 9 General Fund of the commonwealth; and the budget commis-
- 10 sioner shall include in his budget such sum or sums of money as
- 11 may be necessary for this purpose. The commission on admin-
- 12 istration and finance shall direct the transfer from the Highway
- 13 Fund, of such sum or sums of money so expended for salaries, to
- 14 the General Fund of the commonwealth.
