## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS IN WARDS TEN AND ELEVEN IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section thir-  
2 teen of chapter six hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nine-  
3 teen hundred and sixty or any other provision of law to the  
4 contrary, no building which exceeds sixty-five feet in height  
5 shall be constructed in wards ten and eleven of the city of Bos-  
6 ton and no garage or building which includes a garage shall be  
7 constructed in said ward within five hundred feet of a church,  
8 a public or private school having more than fifty pupils or a  
9 public or private hospital having more than twenty-five beds.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
