AN ACT PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNERS FOR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE DUMPING OF SEWAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized to reimburse certain property owners and abutters
3 in the town of Winthrop for damage resulting from the dump-
4 ing of sewage in connection with the construction of the sewage
5 treatment plant at Deer Island. For said purposes the commis-
6 sion may expend a sum not to exceed fifty thousand dollars from
7 funds provided by chapter five hundred and fifteen of the acts
8 of nineteen hundred and sixty-one. This authorization shall
9 expire on December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sixty-
10 two.

1 SECTION 2. To assist the metropolitan district commission
2 in carrying out the provisions of this act, there is hereby created
3 a board of three persons who shall be residents of the town of
4 Winthrop, two to be appointed by the governor, and one to be
5 designated by the attorney general. Each member of the board
6 shall receive twenty-five dollars for each day or portion thereof
7 spent in the performance of his official duties; provided, that
8 the total sum paid to any member thereof shall not exceed
9 twenty-five hundred dollars in any one year. Said compensa-
10 tion and expenses of said board shall be paid out of the funds
11 authorized to be expended under chapter one of this act. Each
12 member of the board shall under the penalties of perjury sub-
13 mit a bill for such compensation and shall set forth therein the
14 dates when, and the purposes for which, such duties were per-
15 formed before allowance by the comptroller.
