Ordered, That the committee on state administration is hereby authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of so much of the Governor's Address as relates to economic development and urban renewal, area development and state planning (see Senate, No. 1, pages 14-15), and the subject matter of current senate document numbered 638, relative to the establishment of a department of economic development and community renewal and formation of regional and municipal planning districts. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other assistance and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of December in the current year.
