## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE TO THE BRIGHTON LODGE #2199, BENEVOLENT AND PROTECTIVE ORDER OF ELKS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of licenses to
- 2 be issued under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter
- 3 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but subject,
- 4 however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the licensing
- 5 board of the city of Boston is hereby authorized to issue to the
- 6 Brighton Lodge #2199, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks
- 7 of the United States of America, an annual license to sell all alco-
- 8 holic beverages, to be drunk on its premises, to members and to
- 9 guests introduced by such members and to no others.
- 10 Said license shall not be transferable to any other licensee and
- 11 shall not be included in the number of licenses issued under au-
- 12 thority of said section seventeen; provided, however, that if
- 13 there is an addition to the quota of such licenses in said city
- 14 under said section seventeen because of an increase in popula-
- 15 tion in said city, then said license shall be included in such new
- 16 quota.
