

HOUSE No. 3866

Substituted by the House, on motion of Mrs. Newman of Cambridge (in part), for a Bill establishing the executive office for Administration and Finance to promote greater efficiency and economy and to strengthen the structure of government (printed in House, No. 3232, App. A, changed). June 25.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Ordered, That the committee on State Administration is hereby authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current senate document numbered 607, relative to the term of office of certain department heads and others, and of current house document numbered 2600, relative to promoting executive responsibility by adjusting the terms of office of certain department heads and others. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other assistance and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of December in the current year.
