The committee on Ways and Means, to whom were referred the Bill extending the Metropolitan parks district (printed in House, No. 3775, App. A, changed); the Bill authorizing the Department of Public Works to transfer to the Metropolitan District Commission the care and control of certain bridges (printed in House, No. 3775, App. B); the Bill authorizing the Department of Public Works to transfer to the Metropolitan District Commission the Truman Highway in Boston and Milton (printed in House, No. 3775, App. C); the Bill authorizing the Department of Public Works to transfer to the Metropolitan District Commission certain portions of state highways no longer needed for state highway purposes, subject to limited access conditions (printed in House, No. 3775, App. D); and the Bill providing that public hearings be held on certain proposed improvements or extensions of the Metropolitan parks district and that due notices thereof be given to member cities and towns (printed in House, No. 3775, App. E) report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 3869).

RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CERTAIN ACTIVITIES OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission shall
2 include in its investigation and study of certain activities of
3 the metropolitan district the subject matter of current house
4 documents numbered 3775, Appendix A, extending the metro-
5 politan parks district; Appendix B, authorizing the department
6 of public works to transfer to the metropolitan district commis-
7 sion the care and control of certain bridges; Appendix C, au-
8 thorizing the department of public works to transfer to the
9 metropolitan district commission the Truman highway in
10 Boston and Milton; Appendix D, authorizing the department
11 of public works to transfer to the metropolitan district com-
12 mission certain portions of state highways no longer needed
13 for state highway purposes, subject to limited access conditions;
14 and Appendix E, providing that public hearings be held on
15 certain proposed improvements or extensions of the metropoli-
16 tan parks district and that due notices thereof be given to mem-
17 ber cities and towns.
