RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING THE COLUMBIA BROADCASTING SYSTEM ON ITS PRESENTATION OF A SPECIAL POLITICAL PROGRAM.

Whereas, On June 8th, 1962, the Columbia Broadcasting System in its special feature program entitled "Eye Witness" made a special presentation of the problems and demands made on persons in political life in Massachusetts; and

Whereas, On this program different persons elected to political office in Massachusetts were afforded the opportunity to tell their story directly to the public; and

Whereas, It was fortunate that one of those interviewed was Representative James F. Condon from the seventh Suffolk District of Boston. A dedicated member of the House of Representatives since 1947, Representative Condon was able to acquaint the public with some of the problems of the average legislator, and as a man dedicated to assisting the youth of the commonwealth, when describing in a small way some of his accomplishments in this field the public were therefore acquainted with some of the little known activities of the average legislator that too often go unnoticed; therefore be it

Resolved, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives hereby congratulates the Columbia Broadcasting System on its fairness in the presentation of this eye witness program thereby acquainting the public in an unbiased manner with some of the problems confronting the average person in political life; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be sent by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the Columbia Broadcasting System and to Representative James F. Condon.
