AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TAUNTON TO PAY TO THOMAS E. MCCARTHY, A MEMBER OF ITS MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, THE COMPENSATION ATTACHED TO SAID OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section ninety-
2 one of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws or any other law
3 to the contrary, the city of Taunton is hereby authorized to
4 pay to Thomas E. McCarthy, who was retired by said city in
5 March, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, the compensation
6 attached to the office of councillor to which he was elected at the
7 biennial municipal election in the year nineteen hundred and
8 forty-seven.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LONDON TO PAY TO THOMAS W. MORTIMER, A MEMBER OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, THE COMPENSATION ATTACHED TO SAID OFFICE.

Enacted by the Queen and House of Commons in Great Council assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Whereas the provisions of section thirty-two of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws or any other law in that behalf made, whereby authority is given to the Council of the City of London to pay to Thomas W. Mortimer, who was elected by said City in the year nineteen hundred and forty-eight, the compensation attached to the office of member in which he was elected at the general municipal election in the year nineteen hundred and forty-seven.

2. That the said act shall take effect upon its passage.
