Sir,

I had the pleasure this morning to receive your letter of the 5th inst with a sketch of part of Martineau Rock on which Mr Bryant has marked three places, B. C. & D at which he is willing to throw out a rock sufficient to admit Boats safely for 275⁰⁰ all day, I have accordingly authorized Mr. Anderson to employ Mr. Bryant on these terms to do the work before he leaves the Island.

I should be much obliged to you to send me a sketch of the whole Island with the new Light House marked on it; and also the several landings for Boats which Mr. Bryant is to make there. I do not want it a finished drawing but merely a rough sketch giving an Idea of the extent of the Island and the position of the Light.
