### RESOLVE

In favor of Catherine Corrigan.

1 *Resolved*, That Catherine Corrigan, widow of Thomas  
2 H. Corrigan, who served in the war of the rebellion in  
3 the general service of the United States, and is now  
4 dead, and who was a citizen of Boston at the time of his  
5 enlistment, shall, from and after March first of the  
6 present year, be eligible to receive state aid under the  
7 rules, provisions and limitations of chapter three hun-  
8 dred and one of the acts of the year eighteen  
9 hundred and eighty-nine, in the same manner and to  
10 the same extent she would have been entitled had her  
11 husband served to the credit of this Commonwealth.
