AN ACT

Relating to Fees for Detention and Support of
Prisoners in Lock-ups.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section thirty-four of chapter
2 twenty-seven of the Public Statutes relating to
3 the powers and fees of keepers of lock-ups, is
4 hereby amended by adding at the end of said
5 section the following words: "No fee for deten-
6 tion and support shall be taxed or allowed under
7 this section unless it shall appear by the officer's
8 return that the defendant was actually detained
9 in the lock-up."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
