### AN ACT

To Authorize the Town of Winchester to Raise Money to Celebrate the Two Hundred and Fiftieth Anniversary of the First White Settlement Within its Territory.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Winchester is  
2 authorized to raise by taxation a sum of money  
3 not exceeding one thousand dollars, for the pur-  
4 pose of celebrating the two hundred and fiftieth  
5 anniversary of the first white settlement within  
6 its territory.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
