AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Payment of State and Military Aid and for Expenses in connection therewith.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 one, to wit:—

8 For reimbursement to cities and towns for
9 money paid on account of State and military
10 aid to Massachusetts volunteers and their
11 families, a sum not exceeding four hundred and
12 fifty thousand dollars, the same to be paid on
13 or before the first day of December, in the
14 year eighteen hundred and ninety-one. [Acts
15 1889, chaps. 279 and 301.]

16 For postage, printing and other necessary
17 expenses in carrying out the provisions of the
18 State and military aid laws, a sum not exceed-
19 ing five hundred dollars. [Acts 1889, chaps.
20 279 and 301.]

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
