AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts
Homœopathic Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum hereinafter mentioned
2 is appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 in aid of the Massachusetts homœopathic hospital
5 in the city of Boston to wit: —

6 For the Massachusetts homœopathic hospital for
7 the purpose of building and furnishing an addition
8 to the present building, or erecting and furnishing
9 new buildings, the sum of sixty thousand dollars,
10 as authorized by chapter three hundred and fifty-
11 eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
12 and ninety, being in addition to the sum of sixty
13 thousand dollars appropriated by chapter four
14 hundred and thirty-three of the acts of the year
15 eighteen hundred and ninety.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
