AN ACT

To authorize Frederick W. Dickinson and Others to build a Bridge over Tide Water at Osterville in the Town of Barnstable.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Frederick W. Dickinson, Richard
2 M. Winfield, Frederick P. Forster and John H.
3 Murphy are hereby authorized to build and main-
4 tain a bridge over the channel connecting north
5 and south bays, so called, in the village of
6 Osterville in the town of Barnstable, subject
7 to the provisions of chapter nineteen of the
8 Public Statutes, and of any other laws which
9 now are or hereafter may be in force applicable
10 thereto. Said bridge shall be open to the public,
11 and shall have a draw therein of not less than
12 thirty feet in width, which shall be opened when-
13 ever necessary for the passage of boats and ves-
14 sels through the same.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
