### AN ACT

To incorporate the Winthrop Loan and Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Albert H. Davenport, Albert A.  
2 Pope, Alonzo H. Evans, Samuel R. Payson,  
3 Elisha S. Converse, Wilmot R. Evans, James H.  
4 Eaton and William T. Hart, their associates and  
5 successors, are hereby made a corporation by the  
6 name of the Winthrop loan and trust company  
7 with authority to establish and maintain a safe  
8 deposit, loan and trust company in the city of  
9 Boston; with all the powers and privileges and  
10 subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions  
11 set forth in all general laws which now are or  
12 may hereafter be in force relating to such corpo-  
13 rations.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
