AN ACT

Changing the Time of the Law Term of the Supreme Judicial Court in the County of Bristol, and the sitting of the Superior Court for Civil Business for the County of Bristol.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The term of the supreme judicial
2 court for entering and hearing questions of law in
3 the counties of Bristol, Dukes county and Nan-
4 tucket, now required to be held at Taunton on
5 the fourth Tuesday of October in each year, shall
6 hereafter be held at Taunton on the fourth Mon-
7 day of October in each year.

1 SECT. 2. The superior court for civil business,
2 for the county of Bristol, now required to be held
3 at Taunton within and for the county of Bristol
4 on the first Monday of September in each year,
5 shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of
6 September in each year.
