## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-one.

### AN ACT

To Transfer the Inspection of Public Buildings and School-houses from the District Police to the Local Boards of Health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter one  
2 hundred and forty-nine of the acts of the year  
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, entitled "an  
4 act to cause proper sanitary provisions and  
5 proper ventilation in public buildings and school-  
6 houses," is hereby amended by striking out, at  
7 the end of said section, the words "the inspection  
8 department of the district police force," and

9 inserting in place thereof the words "the board  
10 of health of the city or town in which such  
11 building is situated."

1 SECT. 2. Section three of said chapter is hereby  
2 amended by striking out, in lines one and two, the  
3 words "an inspection of factories and public  
4 buildings," and by inserting in place thereof the  
5 words "such board of health."

1 SECT. 3. Section four of said chapter is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in the third line  
3 thereof, the words "an inspector," and inserting  
4 in place thereof the words "the board of health."

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
