AN ACT

To Establish the Salaries of the Register and Assistant Register of Probate and Insolvency for the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the register of pro-
2 bate and insolvency for Middlesex county shall
3 be twenty-two hundred dollars a year, and that
4 of the assistant register of probate and insolvency
5 for the same county, two thousand dollars a year,
6 from the first day of January in the year eighteen
7 hundred ninety-one.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
