RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Repairs at the Massachusetts Reformatory.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of
2 the treasury of the Commonwealth, to be expended at
3 the Massachusetts reformatory, under the directions of the
4 commissioners of prisons, the following sums, to wit:—
5 for the purchase and repair of library books, not exceed-
6 ing five hundred dollars; for painting and papering the
7 houses occupied by subordinate officers, not exceeding one
8 thousand dollars; for painting the chapel, not exceeding
9 eight hundred dollars; for plumbing in the cells, not
10 exceeding eight thousand dollars; for repairing the brick
11 wall around the prison yard, not exceeding three thou-
12 sand dollars.
