RESOLVE

Concerning Defence of Proceedings for Damages under Chapter Four Hundred and Thirty-nine of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-nine.

1 *Resolved*, That the superior court may allow such sum
2 as it may deem reasonable for assistance to the district
3 attorneys in the defence of proceedings in that court for
4 damages, or otherwise, under chapter four hundred and
5 thirty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
6 eighty-nine, relating to a system of sewage disposition
7 for the Mystic and Charles river valleys; and the sum so
8 allowed shall be deemed part of the expenses incurred
9 under the provisions of said act, and shall be paid in the
10 same manner as such expenses.
