AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Extermination of the Insect known as the *Ocneria Dispar* or Gypsy Moth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding fifty thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the
4 ordinary revenue, for the purpose of continuing
5 the work of exterminating the insect known as
6 the *ocneria dispar* or gypsy moth, as authorized
7 by chapter one hundred and one of the resolves
8 of the present year.

(Appropriation, 1890, \$50,000.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
