## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-one.

### AN ACT

To Incorporate the University Club of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Walbridge A. Field, John Lowell,  
2 William Gaston, Phillips Brooks, James M.  
3 Barker, Henry L. Higginson, Winslow Warren,  
4 John Fiske, Moses Williams, Stephen M. Crosby,  
5 George M. Towle, Alfred Hemenway, Maurice  
6 H. Richardson, Arthur C. Walworth, Arthur  
7 Little, Richard H. Dana, their associates and suc-  
8 cessors are hereby made a corporation by the  
9 name of the University Club, to be located in the  
10 city of Boston, for the purpose of the promotion  
11 of literature and art, and for other lawful pur-  
12 poses, by establishing and maintaining in said  
13 city a club-house, library, reading-room and gal-  
14 lery of art, and by such other means as shall be  
15 expedient and proper, with the powers and privi-

16 leges, and subject to the duties, liabilities and  
17 restrictions set forth in the general laws, which  
18 now are or may hereafter be in force applicable  
19 to such corporations.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation for the purposes  
2 aforesaid may hold real and personal estate, ex-  
3 clusive of the value of its library and art collec-  
4 tion, to an amount not exceeding two hundred  
5 and fifty thousand dollars. And the said cor-  
6 poration may issue bonds and may execute mort-  
7 gages upon its real estate to an amount not  
8 exceeding the value of such real estate and the  
9 improvements thereon.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
