RESOLVE

In favor of the Messengers and Pages of the Senate and House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth, in addition to the sums
3 now provided by law, the sum of one hundred dollars
4 each to the door-keepers, postmaster and messengers of
5 the senate and house of representatives, and to the clerk
6 and messengers of the sergeant-at-arms, the extra clerks
7 of the senate and house, the clerk in the document room,
8 the messengers of the expenditure committee and the two
9 elevator men, and the sum of sixty-seven dollars to each
10 page.
